



Course Retirement Policy

AMT from time to time will retire courses in the AMT Learning Center.

1. Retired courses are not eligible for refund unless course is within the parameters of the AMT Course Refund Policy
2. Courses marked as “retired” no longer adhere to the originally specified expiration date.
3. Retired courses are no longer accessible in the AMT Learning Center
 - a. Exception – Practice Exams
4. Select courses will have a replacement course.
 - a. If your course has an eligible replacement and the course status is currently “not started” or “in progress” you will automatically be enrolled in the replacement course.
 - i. If course does not have an eligible replacement users will be notified 30 days prior to retirement to complete course. Courses not completed in this timeframe will no longer be accessible and eligible for CE.
 - b. Notification from AMT Learning will be received for course replacement eligible members on date of course release.
 - c. Exceptions – Study Resources
 - i. Practice Exam – exams will remain eligible for users to complete. Additional purchases will be for updated version.
 - ii. Fundamentals – users who have purchased within one calendar year of release of updated version and have a status of “not started” or “in progress” will be automatically enrolled in updated version.
